On September 11, 2001 the world lost over **3,000 of its citizens** in a coordinated act of terrorism that took place in three places on American soil -- at the World Trade Center Plaza (New York City, New York), at the Pentagon (Arlington, Virginia), and in a rural field near Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

A group of hijackers, posing as law abiding persons, forcefully took command of four U.S. commercial long-haul jets that took off from East Coast airports and bound for West Coast destinations. As a result of their evil actions, American Airlines Flight 11 was flown into the upper floors of the World Trade Center - North Tower, United Airlines Flight 175 was flown into the upper floors of the adjacent World Trade Center - South Tower shortly after. Moments later, American Airlines Flight 77 was flown into the West Wall of the Pentagon (Headquarters of the U.S. Department of Defense). As a result of the courageous actions of several passengers, a fourth airplane, United Airlines Flight 93 was prevented from striking yet another target, and ultimately crashed in a rural field near Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

Below are the names of the innocent victims of this evil act of terror. They --the victims-- were fathers, mothers, daughters and sons, grandparents, and loved ones from all households and works of life. They simply woke up that fateful morning -- hoping to live another day of productive lives. On this **10th Year Anniversary**, we **celebrate their lives and honor their memory**. Also, we **remember the men and women of the military**, as well as members of U.S. diplomatic missions around the world, who are still today in harm's way, and many of whom have since (9/11) made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their country. Their sacrifice preserves the freedom of all of us.
